



The Region of Durham is seeking volunteers from Durham Region for a committee that will play an advisory role on the recently approved Energy to Waste facility in Courtice.

According to the Region, the Energy from Waste - Waste Management Advisory Committee (EFW-WMAC) will meet on a quarterly basis and act in an advisory role to the Durham Works Committee on issues or concerns which arise with waste diversion, waste management, environmental performance and monitoring of the waste incinerator facility, including the construction and operational phases.
