Area Halloween hotspots include:

The Courtice Flea Market is holding a Halloween event on Sunday, October 30th. The event features free pumpkins (from 11 am to 2 pm, while supplies last), a pumpkin carving contest for various ages, trick or treating with the vendors, face painting and a Halloween themed stage show from 11 am to 1 pm. Knox's Pumpkin Farm offers Halloween fun between 10 am to 5 pm throughout the month of October. Wagon rides, a straw jump, pumpkin picking and a corn maze are among the attractions.
